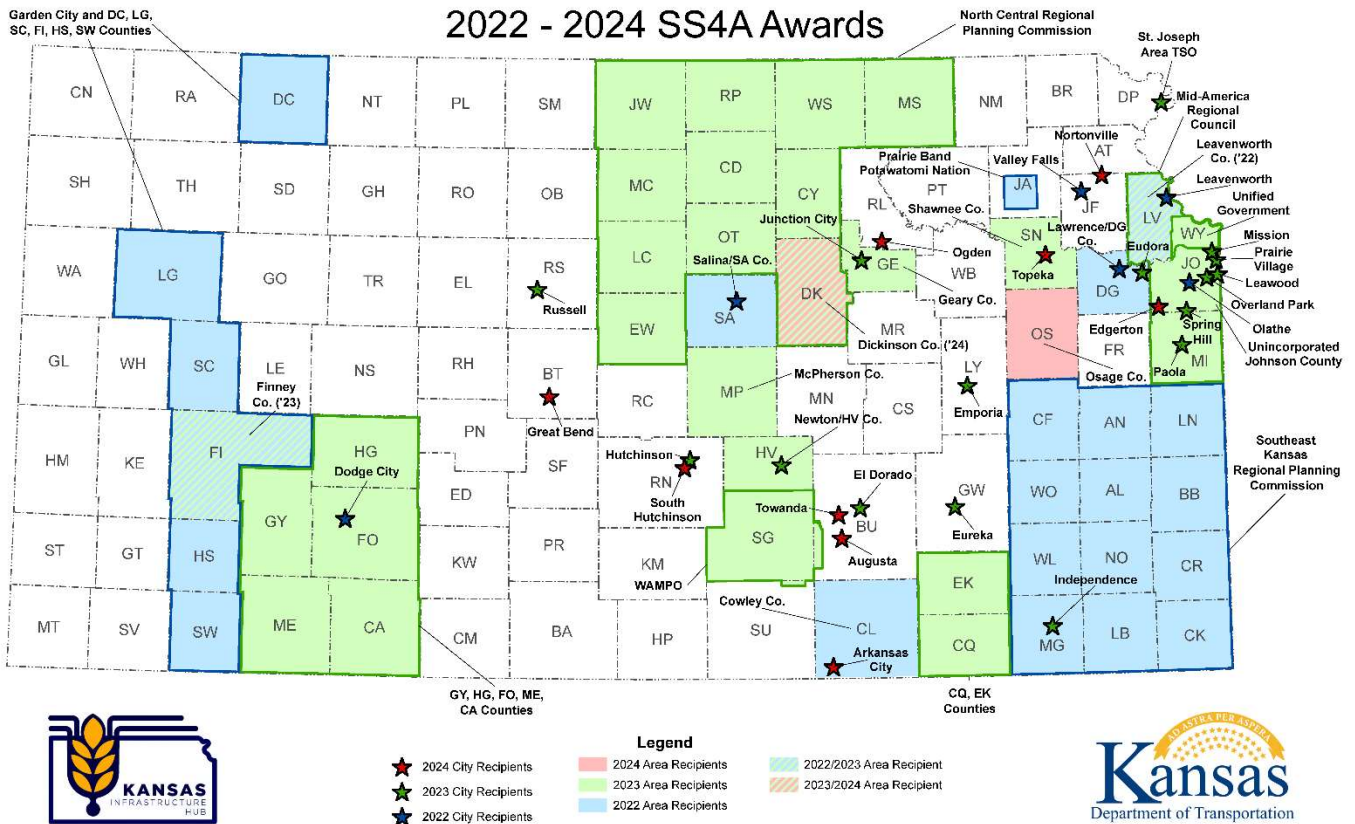


Kansas Safe Streets and Roads For All (SS4A)



The **Safe Streets and Roads for All** program provides funding aimed at reducing transportation fatalities and injuries on Kansas roadways.

As of 2025, 49 Kansas applicants have been awarded over \$21 million from the U.S. DOT and over \$4 million of state funds to improve safety on roads and streets. **Over 80% of the Kansas population lives in areas where this funding will help reduce or eliminate serious-injury and fatal crashes** affecting all roadway users.

Since the **Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A)** program started in 2022, communities in Kansas have received \$21.12 million in federal funds for Comprehensive Safety Action Plan development and safety project implementation from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law. Through the Kansas SS4A Match Pilot Program (2022 and 2023) and the Build Kansas Fund (2024 and beyond), the State of Kansas has contributed \$4.34 million toward the local public agency match. SS4A is a 5-year, \$5 billion federal program. The program covers up to 80% of project costs through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL), with state and local public agencies covering the rest.

The **Kansas Infrastructure Hub** connects multiple state agencies and serves as a resource center for Kansas communities to identify best practices for maximizing BIL funding opportunities. The **Build Kansas Fund** provides state matching dollars for projects throughout Kansas that successfully apply for federal grants under BIL. In 2023, the Kansas Legislature and Governor Kelly approved \$200 million for the Build Kansas Fund to provide state matching dollars to Kansas entities and projects to meet federal local match requirements.
